Key Activities

Students participated in a circuit of games in which they competed for bragging rights as a part of team! After the games concluded, students learned about the power of **Belonging** to something larger than themselves. The original Hebrew and Greek bibles described “love” in 4 different ways where as our English language only has one. Students learned about “Phila” which means “brotherly love”. We learned that “LOVE” is an **ACTION** that often times requires sacrifice, but with a community around us, we are capable of much more than we think we are, and our love for one another drives us to push through challenges and overcome the obstacles we are faced with in life!
