➤ **Purpose**

➤ **Award**

- ✓ Two \$4000 per year renewable scholarships to graduating seniors at GCHS, NGA, LOA or GCCA
- ✓ Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college/university/technical institute/business or industry offering a certified training program as confirmed by the recipient and placed in his/her spending account.
- ✓ Scholarship finalists will be selected by a selection team and will submit to an interview with the Lawton family; the final recipients will be announced in May 2019.

➤ **Application Requirements**

- ✓ Must be legal resident of Greene County, GA, as of the application date
- ✓ Must be current GCHS, NGA, LOA or GCCA senior in good academic standing
- ✓ Must be currently or previously enrolled in an ATLAS After School program, a HOPE course, or a Christian Learning Center course

**Must write an essay to highlight what you have gained *through the leadership roles, extracurricular activities, or classroom activities* in which you have participated, to include:**

- ✓ the impact of the experience on you
- ✓ what you contributed to the experience
- ✓ what you learned about yourself
- ✓ how the experience has helped shape your plans for the future

**Submit complete application by **February 8, 2019**, with this cover.** Check to be sure you have filled out all required pages and information and have submitted the following:

- ✓ school counselor signature verifying academic standing
- ✓ financial information
- ✓ official transcripts from high school
- ✓ official scores from either SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer Test
- ✓ letters of recommendation
